Other Site Characteristics

Die Siegendorfer Pußta und Heide liegen an einer NW - SE verlaufenden Geländekante am südlichen Rande des Wulkabeckens. Der Untergrund besteht aus fossilreichen pannonen Sanden, die tiefgründig entkalkt sind. Ursprünglich Weideland, sind die Flächen wegen bereits lange zurückliegender Nutzung stark verbracht und verbuscht. Neben den Sandtrockenrasen sind auffallende Elemente der Bestand mit Juniperus communis, sowie die, in der Mulde am Fuße der Trockenhänge gelegene, binnenländische Salzsumpfwiese. Auch diese ist wegen der ausgefallenen Nutzung stark verbracht und mit Phragmites communis durchsetzt.

4.2 Quality and importance

Das Gebiet enthält besonders ausgebildete Sand-Trockenrasen mit kleinflächig offener, für das Burgenland einzigartiger, Sand-Pioniervegetation. In dieser überaus seltenen Lebensgemeinschaft finden einige Pflanzenarten ihr einziges Vorkommen im Burgenland. Bemerkenswert ist das Vorkommen einer kleinen Zieselkolonie und der Wacholder-Bestand. Größte Salzsumpfwiese ausserhalb des Neusiedler See Gebietes.
